

Draw Conditions!

The intention of the \$5,000 prize money is to assist the winner to attend the 2011 Australian 4 Day Enduro (A4DE). We hope to spend the entire amount and our best estimate is that a rider already with all the necessary equipment (which you obviously have, having just finished the M3DE) will need to spend approximately \$5,000 in travel, freight, accommodation and other costs to compete. We just want to encourage the movement of riders across the Tasman as it can only be good for our sport. So if a seasoned A4DE campaigner wins then awesome (dirt biking is an expensive passion) and if it's a first timer equally great (another day, another experience). And if an Aussie wins, well we would love to see them back at M3DE next year.

Now for the formal bit ...

The following conditions apply to the draw for the trip to the 2011 A4DE to the value of \$5,000:

1. Only **official finishers** of the 2010 Honda M3DE are eligible to enter the draw.
2. The winner must be present at the presentation dinner at the time of the draw to be eligible to win the prize. The presentation dinner is scheduled to be held at the Red Fox Tavern on Sunday 5th December 2010 after the completion of the event.
3. Upon entry to the presentation dinner all official finishers will need to collect an official draw slip on which their name will be written to put in a "barrel". The "barrel" will then be on public display throughout the presentation dinner to ensure the integrity of the draw. It is each official finisher's sole responsibility to ensure that their name is in the "barrel" prior to the draw.
4. The draw will occur at the presentation dinner just after the completion of the trophy presentations, which are scheduled to start at approximately 7:30 pm.
5. A suitably appointed independent person will physically make the draw in front of everyone present.
6. The prize is a \$5,000 contribution towards the cost of competing in the 2011 Australian 4 Day Enduro, 21 to 24 April 2011. The maximum value of the contribution is \$5,000.
7. Should the winner be unable to lawfully compete in the A4DE (i.e. not hold a current driver's license, not hold an applicable competition license, unable to obtain clearance or insurance, or unable to legitimately complete for any other reason) then he or she may apply the prize to attending the A4DE as a supporter or pit crew for another rider, with the balance of the prize (after paying the reasonable costs of the winner's attendance) being applicable to the supported rider's costs.

8. Should the winner be an Australian rider the prize can be applied to the costs of competing in the 2011 Honda M3DE in New Zealand.
9. The prize is a maximum contribution of \$5,000. The winner cannot claim any additional expenses above \$5,000, no matter how they occur. Therefore it is the winner's responsibility to pay for all the necessary documentation, licenses, insurance, motorcycle, riding gear, travel costs, entry fees, freight and all other expenses above the \$5,000 contribution.
10. The prize is not redeemable for cash.
11. The prize is not transferable and can only be taken by the actual winner.
12. \$5,000 has been deposited in the Grange Associates Ltd's, Chartered Accountants, trust account and is to be applied only to this purpose.
13. The winner of the draw must agree to the promoters, DRD Magazine and event sponsors being able to use their name, photo and quotations in their publicity, promotional and advertising materials.
14. The draw at the presentation dinner will be final and no discussions will be entered into afterwards whatsoever.
